## CATEGORIES AND AWARD DISTRIBUTION

Artists will be asked to place their entry into one of three categories that they feel best reflects their work:

CATEGORY 1:	Painting / Printmaking / Mixed Media
CATEGORY 2:	Photography / Digital Graphics
CATEGORY 3:	3D Sculpture / Jewellery

One Merit Award will be given out in each category. One Excellence Award will be given out in each category. One Supreme Award will be given to one of the three Excellence Award Recipients. The People's Choice Award will be decided by popular vote which will run throughout the show and announced at the conclusion of the exhibition.

## ENTRY FORMS AND FEES

Each artist must complete the entry form and enclose a \$30 entry fee per entry (or pay via direct debit into the OAS bank account). This fee is non-refundable. Entry forms are to be received no later than **4pm Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2017**.

No late entries will be accepted. Please make cheques payable to "Otago Art Society Inc." **DO NOT ENCLOSE FORM OR FEE WITH ARTWORK.**

**Out of town artworks:** (all categories) must be received no later than Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2017. Inward and outward freight will be the responsibility of the artist. Pre-paid return freight tickets and a return address label for unsold artwork must be included with entry or artwork.

**Local artworks: Categories 1 and 2** (painting, printmaking, mixed media, photography, digital and graphic) must be received on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2017. **Category 3** (3D sculpture and jewellery) must be received on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2017. Drop off between 10am - 4pm.

## VENUES & DATES

Entries which are selected will be exhibited at the Otago Art Society, Dunedin Railway Station. The awards will be announced on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2017 at a private viewing at 6pm to which entrants and members of the Otago Art Society are invited. This exhibition will open to the public on **Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> April - Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2017**.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Open to any Artist residing in New Zealand.
- Multiple entries per artist per category are welcome. Each entry must be accompanied with a separate entry form and fee.
- Works must not have been previously exhibited by the OAS, and not previously received any award.
- All works must be original and completed within the last two years.
- Works must be totally dry, suitably and professionally presented.
- 2D works must not exceed **1000mm (including frame)** on its longest side, with D-rings 75mm from the top.
- 3D works must not exceed 800mm on its longest side. 3D works can be made up of multiple pieces, but must be sold as one item.
- Artist's name as for catalogue, title of work, medium and price must be attached to the work as well as on a swing label.
- Entry fee is non refundable.
- The organisers reserve the right to photograph or reproduce illustrations of selected works, for publicity relating to the exhibition.
- All artworks must be for sale. A **30% commission** will be deducted on all sales.
- Works not collected by **Sunday the 4<sup>th</sup> June 2017** will incur a storage charge of \$10 per week. Work not collected by **Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2017** will be deemed to become the property of the OAS, to be disposed of at its discretion.

## SELECTION - JUDGES

Artists will be notified of selection or non-selection. The Judges will announce the award winners on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> April. The judges' selection shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into. The Otago Art Society has no part in the selection process other than all entries adhering to the conditions of entry.
